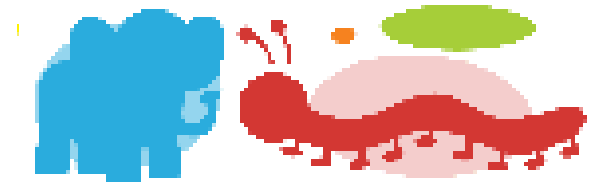


# Animals overview
